
# Supporting country efforts for high performing health systems



# Health systems are facing mounting pressures and challenges


- National HSPA frameworks offer a comprehensive, yet concise overview of health systems, supporting evidence-based policymaking

# HSPAs help ensure health systems meet people's needs and deliver high-quality care

**National HSPA is a systematic evaluation,  
bridging an information gap between data and decisions.**

## What is an HSPA?

- > An indicator-based monitoring tool of health system performance
- > Designed to provide evidence for policymaking
- > Tailored to national priorities

## Whose is HSPA?

- > Country-owned and managed
- > Co-developed with stakeholders


## What it also brings?

- > Drives data infrastructure development
- > Enhances collaboration nationally and internationally
- > Creates stakeholder buy-in through co-production
- > Promotes shared understanding of the health system among national stakeholders




# National HSPA connects performance areas to support evidence-informed policy making

## Electronic medical record exchange levels remain low in Luxembourg





## Health risks in Luxembourg reveal scope for targeted actions





