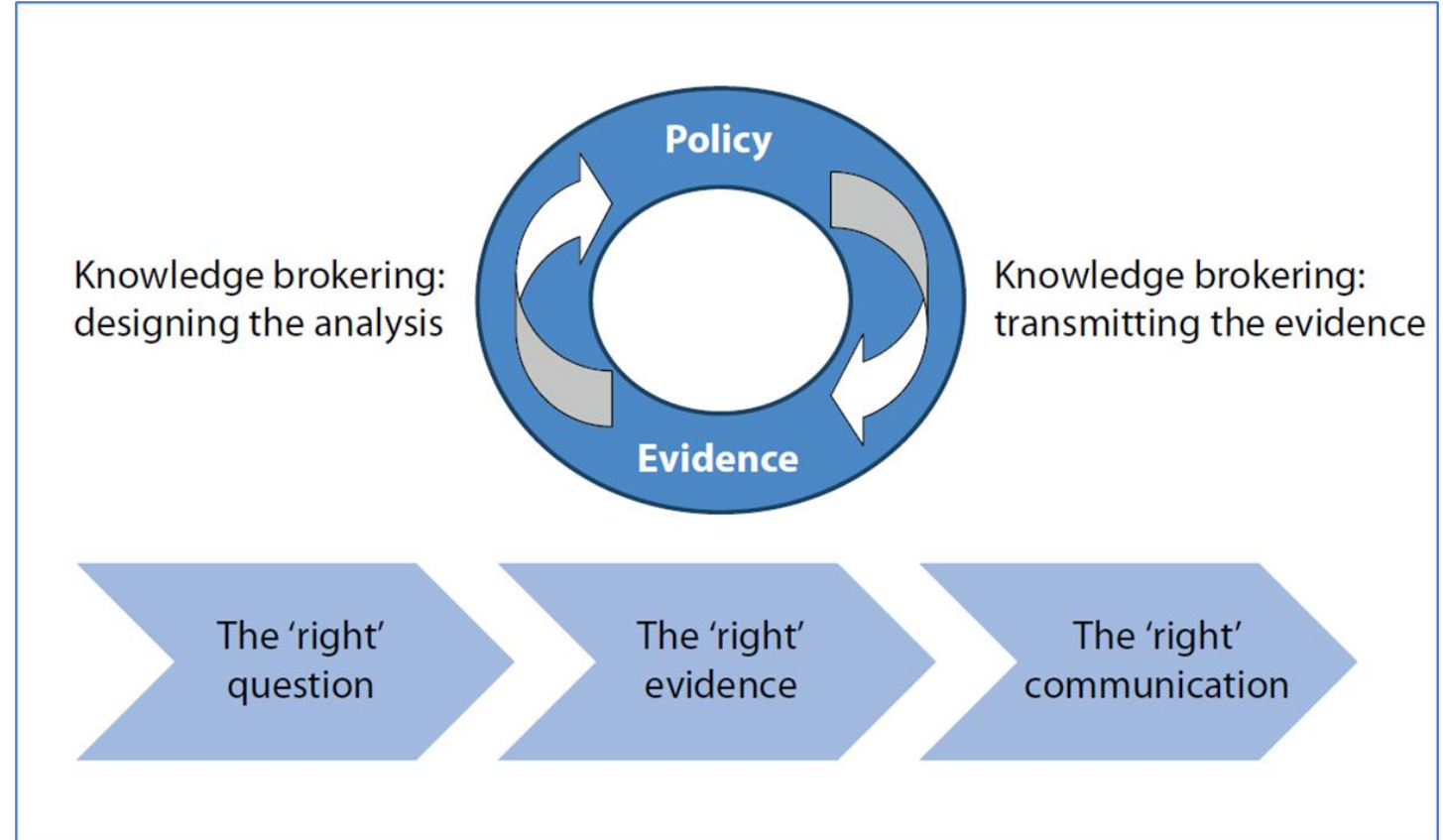

Country monitoring

Country monitoring offers policy-makers

- ❖ Consistent, comparable descriptions of health system
- ❖ Updates on reforms
- ❖ Access to networks
- ❖ Entry points for discussions in countries

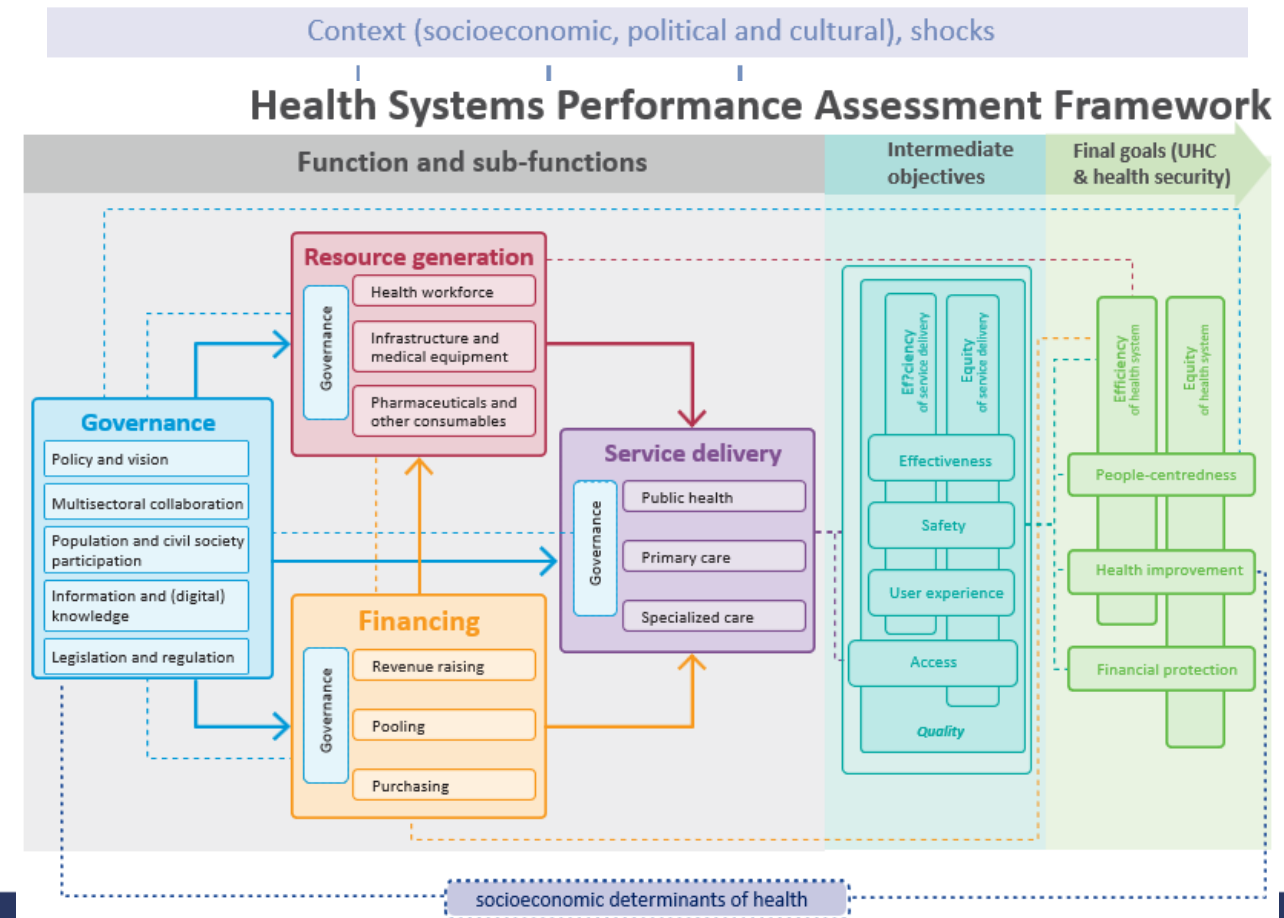
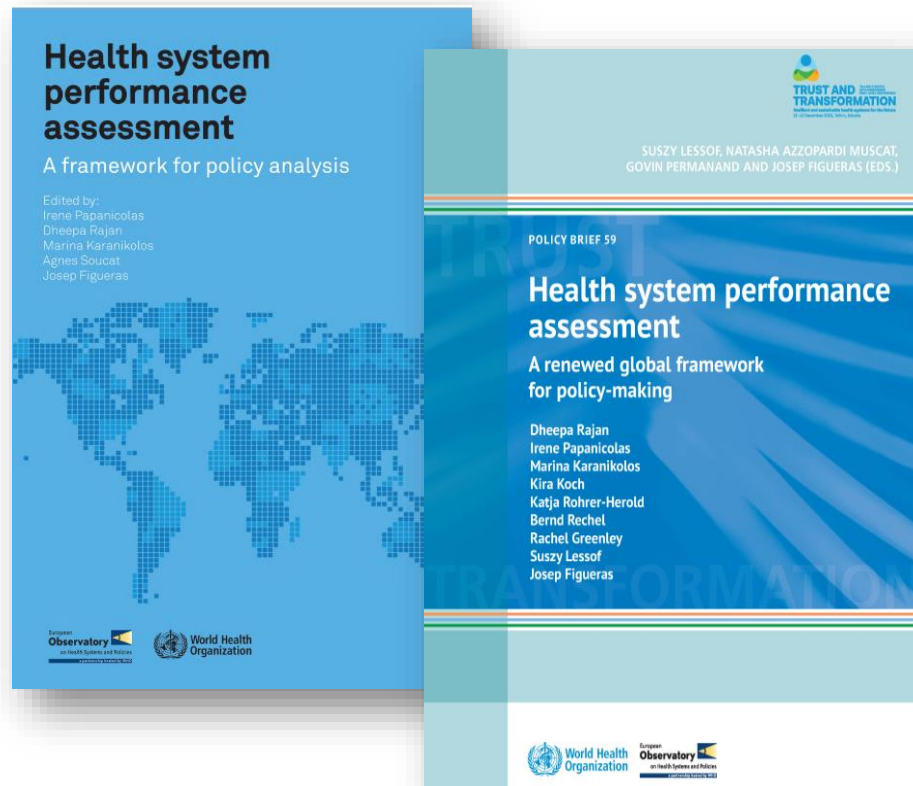


Analysis supports policy-makers through

- ❖ In-depth analysis, primers and studies
- ❖ Policy briefs
- ❖ Short studies, case studies and articles
- ❖ Rapid evidence responses
- ❖ A pool of evidence that feeds into policy dialogue and country work and shares understanding.



- ❖ **HSPA offers policy-makers** a structured and consistent way of looking at a health system, diagnosing problems and testing solutions. The work of the HiT is indispensable for HSPA. It provides the qualitative information and the context to make sense of the quantitative data.

Why monitoring health systems?

- Providing an **in-depth description** of the health systems using a **standardized template** to deliver an overview and offer a basis for comparison
- Gives a common ground for everyone to talk about HiTs in the same way using **reliable systematic information**
- **Assessing the performance** of a health system, understanding its structures and functions supports improvement

What is a HiT?



HiTs are the **classic flagship series** of the Observatory, which are **consistent** and **clearly sign posted**, across **countries** and **across time**, and provide **comparable data** to describe and analyze European health systems.

Cross-country HiTs



How do policy-makers use country monitoring?

- **Examine different approaches** to the organisation, financing and delivery of health services, and the role of actors
- Describe the **institutional framework** for and the process, content and implementation of health policy;
- **Highlight challenges** and areas requiring more detailed analysis;
- Provide a **tool for disseminating information** on health systems;
- Facilitate **the exchange of reform experiences** across countries;
- Establish a **baseline** for assessing the impact of reforms; and
- Inform **comparative analysis** and **teaching**.
- Identify **emerging trends**

Increasing need for timely information requires a network

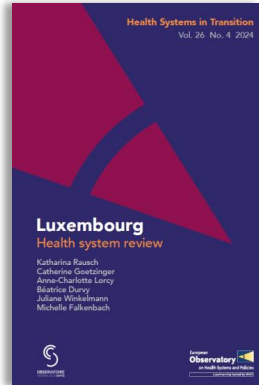
- The **Health Systems and Policy Monitor (HSPM)** developed over the last 10 years as a network and a **core European Observatory resource**.

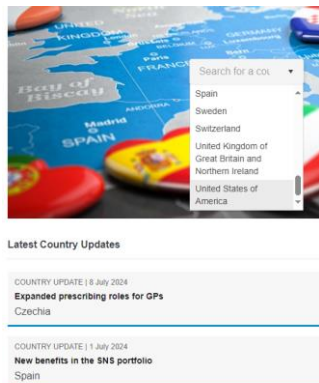

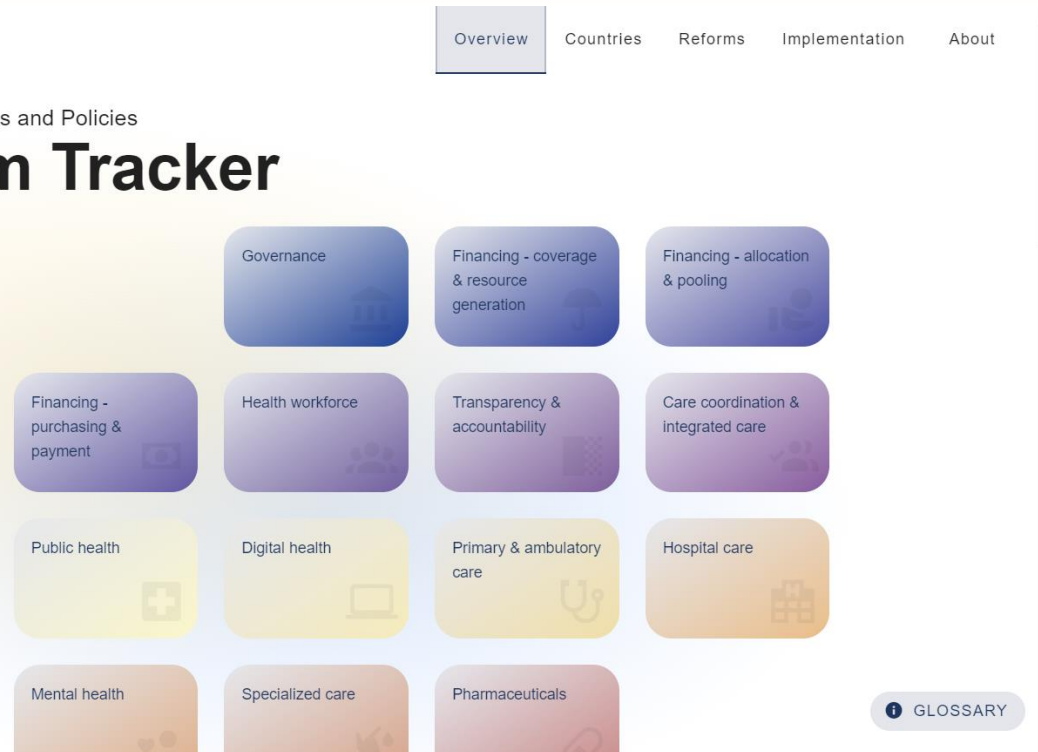

Health Reform Tracker

The Health Reform Tracker provides a first-ever overview of the content and dynamics of health reforms in over 30 countries across the WHO European Region and North America over time. The Observatory's [Health System Policy Monitor \(HSPM\)](#) network of experts has been collecting the "top three" health policy and system reforms for each country annually since 2018. These are organized, validated and synthesized by the Observatory.

The reforms are classified according to two types of clusters - health system functions and care areas - as well as by their type and policy originator.

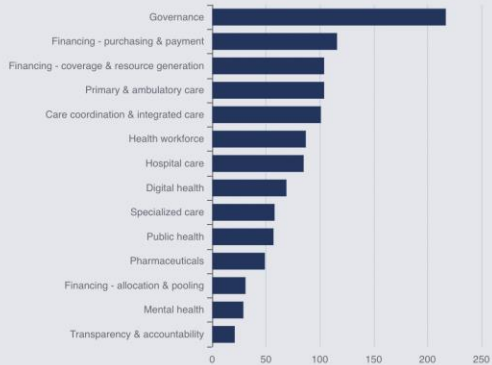

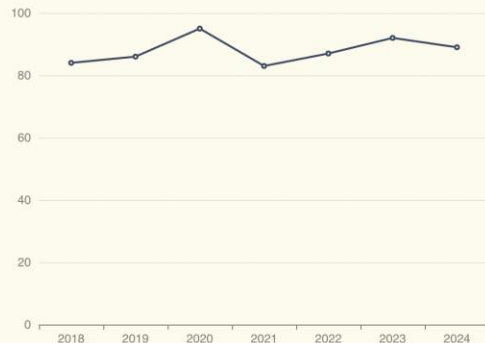

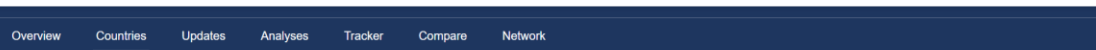
